The Los Angeles Dodgers Foundation (LADF) tackles the most pressing problems facing Los Angeles with a mission to improve education, health care, homelessness, and social justice for all Angelenos. Reimagined in 2013, LADF has since raised over \$204 million. Under its new strategic plan, “Lasting Impact for Los Angeles,” LADF is amplifying best practices, scaling solutions, growing its capacity and refining its work with investments exceeding \$71 million in its programs and grants to local organizations. To date, LADF has positively impacted over 11 million youth. LADF is the proud recipient of ESPN’s Sports Humanitarian Team of the Year, Robert Wood Johnson Sports Award, Beyond Sport’s Sport for Reduced Racial Inequalities Collective Impact Award, and the Aspen Institute Project Play Champion. The Los Angeles Dodgers and the Dodgers Foundation (LADF) have led significant wildfire relief efforts in partnership with LA’s 11 professional sports teams, donating \$8 million to local nonprofits and distributing essential supplies. Key initiatives included a Fanatics-led fundraising campaign, a large-scale distribution event at Dodger Stadium, and the creation of LA County Care Camps, which provided 2,700 displaced youth with mental health support, educational programming, and essential resources. LADF also hosted relief distributions distributing more than 588,000 basic essentials, education resources, and mental health items, and raised additional funds through an online auction. Moving forward, LADF will continue its commitment through grants, equipment donations, building two new Dodgers Dreamfields in Altadena, rebuilding the Palisades YMCA, and Dodger Days community events, ensuring sustained support for affected families and communities.
